The next **GEMS Bible Study** is this Tuesday at 10:00 AM here at the building. These studies are open to the entire congregation.



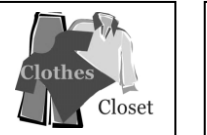

I will ENDURE in my convictions and commitments.

Integrity is required for trust.

If people can't trust your word, they won't trust you. I am reminded of Jesus' words in **Matthew 5:37**, "Let your 'Yes' be 'Yes' and your 'No,' 'No.'" For whatever is more than these is from the evil one. In Jesus' day people took oaths by anything and everything they could see. Ultimately these oaths actually degrade your integrity. If you have to make an oath to keep your word, how trustworthy of a person are you really?

Trust is necessary for influence.

People choose those they let influence them, and this a based largely on trust. Nobody likes being lied to and the people who we choose to spend our time with should be those who can be trusted. If you cannot truly trust your friends are they really your friends? And this goes both ways. If we plan to influence others then we must first prove that we are trustworthy. That means making good on all of our commitments not just the ones that involve them.

Influence is essential for impact.

You can't make the impact you want to make unless you can influence others and shift their behavior. This is the goal: to build up a relationship so that you might influence their lives with the gospel. That is our mission and our calling as disciples who have been tasked with making more disciples. The statement is simple and yet profound, without influence we will not have impact.

Keeping your word is the essence of integrity and ultimately without integrity we cannot be the influential people God calls us to be.

These three statements are at the heart of impacting people with the gospel and making changes in both ourselves and those around us.
